#### Dear friends,

"Keep your lamps trimmed and burning" might seem like an apt refrain as we enter the dark nights of Autumn and Winter and when the days often feel short and rather gloomy; but of course these opening words from the African American spiritual are far from being about British weather. They are words, inspired by Matthew 25: 1-13, which are a call to spiritual readiness.



This preaching Plan covers an extraordinary range of Christian seasons and festivals. It begins with Advent, as we look with joyful expectation to the coming of our Lord Jesus both at Christmas and when He comes again. Then we will celebrate the Good News of the birth of Jesus at Christmas, the Word made flesh. We will observe the massacre of the Holy Innocents on 28th December, which if ever a passage could, reminds us of the heartache in our world still, not least in the Holy Land. We will celebrate Epiphany, when 'outsiders' perceive what 'insiders' often fail to do, that Jesus is Lord. The season also includes Candlemass, that little observed day within Methodism, when Jesus is presented at the Temple, and we see the extraordinary faithfulness of Anna and Simeon, who had kept their lamps trimmed and burning as they waited for the coming of the salvation of the Lord - a light for revelation for the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel. And then, almost immediately, we will begin our Lenten journey to the cross. I feel quite exhausted writing this summary of the next few weeks of preaching and leading worship! And yet what a story we have to tell, of Good News! Of a God who loved the world so much - and still does - that God would consider us worth sending Jesus into it. As Charles Wesley marvelled - "Our God contracted to a span, incomprehensibly made man." (Singing the Faith 208). Yes indeed.

How easy it can be to take the sheer familiarity of our readings and hymns for granted, and almost let them wash over us. "Keep your lamps trimmed and burning" is not a statement about the weather, but about being ready, alert, understanding the times, but above all, being ready for Jesus when He returns whenever that is and whatever time that is. As we worship together over these extraordinary weeks, may we be alert to all that God wants to say to us through worship and our life in the world. So ... preacher, leader of worship, or faithful follower of Jesus, we are all invited to "Keep your lamps trimmed and burning...for the time is drawing nigh."


